



## Center Subaru Tokeneke Classic Road Race August 12, 2018 – East Hartland, CT

### Fact Sheet

- Registration opens at 7:30 am for morning races and 10:30 am for races that start at 11:30 or later. Registration is at Berg Field.
- Start at the E. Hartland volunteer firehouse and proceed south on 179, in a clockwise direction around the reservoir.
- Feed Zone on Rt. 20 / No. Hollow Road. Neutral water will be supplied by the Promoter **No Feeding Allowed Outside of Feed Zone.**
- Finish line is approximately 500 meters from end of Feed Zone. Markers to Finish will be at 500, 300, 200 and 100 meters to go
- Prizes - Cash prizes awarded to top finishers by category after the race, except Junior and Cat-5 fields. Prizes and medal awards will be in the Registration area at Berg Field after the races.
- Neutral Wheel Support by : NRS and Events powered by LOOK
  - Morning: Cat-4 Men-Under-40, Cat-4 Men-40 +
  - Afternoon: Pro 1/2 Men, Women 1/2/3
- Wheels In/Out: Based on Volunteer availability *and* a minimum of 10% of the racers per field placing spares in the vehicles, we expect to support Cat-3 Men, Women 4/5, Masters 40+, Masters 50+/ 60+, Cat-5 Men.
- Day-of Payment: Cash or Checks Accepted - Payable To: **RDG Sports LLC**. Credit cards payments accepted and subject to a 3% processing fee.
- Junior Roll-out- Located at the East Hartland School (start) in the parking lot before and after each Junior race.
- Restrooms:
  - Toilets at the School will be open.
  - Portable Toilet Locations: (1) Berg Field parking lot and (2) Near the Finish Line.
- Lap Distance: Each lap is about 22 miles and will take slightly more than one-hour.

#### Championship Points and Affiliations

**CT State and New England Regional Championship:** This is the USAC Championship Road Race for both the "CT State" and "New England Regional" classifications. Any U.S. citizen or permanent resident with a current USA Cycling license residing in the New England Region, as shown on their license, is eligible for a championship medal. The Center Subaru Tokeneke Classic is open to all licensed riders, but only CT State and New England residents receive State and Regional Championship medals.

**Medals:** CT State and NEBRA regional medals will be awarded for Elite (**except registered Pro Men and Women**) racers. Senior Men and Women for the first three finishers in both Elite categories, regardless of age are eligible. Cat-2 Men are eligible for Gold, Silver and Bronze medals only and will be scored separately. Gold, Silver and Bronze medals will be awarded for the top 3 finishers in the U23 Men in the Pro 1,2 and Women age 19-22 in the Women P1,2,3 fields. Women Cat-3 racing in the Women P1,2,3 field will be eligible for a separate top 3 CT State and NEBRA regional award. CT State and NEBRA regional medals only will be awarded to Junior Men and Women age 11-12,13-14,15-16 and 17-18. Master Men and Women are eligible for CT State and NEBRA regional medals, awarded in 5-year age groups from 40 + up through 70+; Cat 5 Men in both age categories are eligible for Gold, Silver and Bronze medals.

### Number Placement on Jersey

**Number Placement:** Two numbers – small on your back pocket, large on your right rear side (so that the finishing camera can see it).



### Registration – Day-of-the-race Registration will incur a \$20 surcharge

Register on-line at [www.bikereg.com](http://www.bikereg.com) (standard Bikereg service fee applies). Number pick-up will be at Berg Field beginning at 7:30 AM on Race Day. Registration will close 20 minutes before the start of each race. One-day licenses are available for women Cat-4/5 and men Cat-5. Juniors registration fee is \$30.

**Course Description:** The racers start at the E Hartland volunteer firehouse and proceed south on 179, in a clockwise direction around the reservoir, so that racers turn right at intersections. At Routes 179 and 219, (about 4.3mi), racers bear right onto 219 South. At intersection of 219 and 318 (about 6.9 mi), racers bear right onto 318 West and then go over the Saville Dam. Just past the dam at about 7.7 mi, racers turn right onto Beach Rock Road. This is the first climb. At the corner of Beach Rock and 181 (about 8.6 mi), racers turn right on Route 181. In West Hartland (15.9 mi), racers go east on Route 20, completing a lap at the corner of Routes 20 and 179 in East Hartland. See <http://www.tokenekeclassic.com> for course maps.

**Start Line** will be in front of the East Hartland Volunteer Firehouse.

**Finish Line** will be at the top of Rte. 20 / N Hollow Rd. (north from the start on Rte. 179 to the intersection with Rte. 20, then about ½ mile north on Rte. 20. The finish line is about 1K from the crest of the final climb to the finish. For those who raced in 2015 and before, there is now about 1K of false flat/slight uphill to the finish after the main final climb. The old finish line (2015 & earlier) was about 300 Meters past Balance Rock Road. Now it is about 1K from Balance Rock Road.


The official address of the Finish Line is 60 North Hollow Road. There is a sign marking the address of this property on the west side of the road. Here is the link to the race website where it is located:

**Feed Zone** will be approximately 500 hundred meters before the finish line on Rte. 20 at N Hollow Rd. No feeding outside the Feed Zone. Neutral water will be supplied for 3-Lap afternoon races only.


### Race Altitude Profile

### Driving Directions to the Race

**By GPS** – The address of the parking at Berg (Burg) field is, according to Garmin: Burg Field, 93 Hartland Blvd, East Hartland, CT 06027, with Lat/Long coordinates N41.99395 W72.89969 (WGS84).

**Rte. I-91** From I-91, take exit 40 for Rte. 20. Follow signs to Rte. 20 West. Stay on Rte. 20 West through Granby and West Granby. Follow signs for parking at Berg Field in East Hartland. Distance from Exit 40 is approximately 17 miles.

**Rte. I-84** From I-84, take exit for 8-North in Waterbury. Follow 8-North into Winsted (27 miles). Take the US-44/CT-183/CT-8/S Main St exit at end of expressway. Turn LEFT onto 44 East. Stay straight on 44 East 3.5 miles. Turn left onto Ripley Hill Rd/CT-318. Ripley Hill Rd/CT-318 becomes Pleasant Valley Rd/CT-181/CT-318. Turn right onto CT-318/Saville Dam Rd. CT-318/Saville Dam Rd. becomes E Hartland Rd/CT-219. E Hartland Rd/CT-219 becomes E Hartland Rd/CT-179/CT-219. Stay straight on E Hartland Rd/CT-179. Turn right onto 20 East (0.3 miles) to parking at Berg Field.

### Parking

**PARKING IS AT BERG FIELD.** Parking is at Berg (or Burg) Field, on Rte. 20 about 0.3 miles south-east of the Rte.20 / Rte. 179 intersection.
